We are still waiting for official clarification from the Minister for Education Peter Weir, about the restart for P4–P7 children next Monday 22 March. We will be delighted to see all of our pupils back in school and in order to give you time to prepare, please read the following information.

School Starting & Finishing Times and School Bus

The school bus will run as normal from this Monday. If your child is travelling by bus they MUST WEAR A MASK! Early bus in afternoon will be for P1-3 children only.

We will continue with our flexible starting time every morning, of **between 8.50am and 9.10am**. Children will line up on arrival in the school playground, in areas designated by staff. Anyone arriving after 9.10am will be marked late. Parents are not permitted onto the school playground.

The finishing times are the same as they were in December. Please keep these times handy. You should not pick your child up early from school, unless it is an emergency.

Dinners & Snack

- stay within their class bubble at all times
- wash and sanitise their hands regularly throughout the day
- bring their snack and lunch in a wipeable lunch box/bag
- bring a water bottle and a coat
